	Offer volunteer placements for suitably skilled refugees or asylum seekers.	
	Consider appointing refugees to positions of responsibility in your community.	
	Offer meeting space to an asylum or refugee community group.	
	Fundraise for Reading City of Sanctuary or a charity that supports refugees, asylum seekers such as the Reading Refugee Support Group, British Red Cross and Alliance and Cohesion for Racial Equality (Acre)	
	Donate (non-perishable) food items or other items as required to the Reading Refugee Support Group or the Red Cross which help destitute asylum seekers and refugees.	
	Find out about our proposed voluntary hosting project which plans to offer emergency accommodation. (We need people to help organise and publicise this as well as people willing to host someone for a few weeks or months at a time).	
	Publicise City of Sanctuary, Refugee Week and other refugee events within your community.
